## Pastor's Column:



I pray that everyone has a great Thanksgiving Day! This is one of my favorite holidays because of the feasting! I will be back in Ft. Wayne with family Thursday and Friday.

Jesus is often found in the Gospels having big meals with others. He performs his first miracle at the wedding feast of Cana, he has meals with tax collectors and sinners, he has meals with his friends Martha, Mary and Lazarus. Of course, there is also the famous Last Supper feast where Jesus instituted the Eucharistic Feast. Feast is a part of our faith, so we should be especially prepared for the secular holiday of Thanksgiving Day. In fact, the Greek word for “Eucharist” is translated as “thanksgiving.” So here are a couple ideas for this Thursday’s feast.

1. Go to Mass as an act of thanksgiving to God. I know there will be so much to do that morning, but Mass at 9:00am can also be an opportunity to refocus the purpose of the day – thanksgiving to God for all we have. If you cannot make Mass, then visit the chapel or read together a story from the Gospel of Jesus at a feast.
2. When it’s time to eat – turn off the TV and talk to one another. After the Resurrection, Jesus has supper with two pilgrims. After revealing himself in the “Thanksgiving bread” they recount how their hearts were burning as they journeyed with Him on the way. What are ways that you have seen Christ in the past year? Or what are you grateful for in the past year?
3. Play a game and laugh together! Food and laughter are great bonding activities. Silly games that are not too competitive with fast rounds are great ways to bond. (E.g. Dominos, Pictionary, Uno).
