Good Friday Fasting Guidelines:

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection. The Feast of Divine Mercy:



All are invited to celebrate
The Feast of Divine Mercy
Sunday, April 28, 2019
3:00pm

This feast is intended to celebrate and proclaim God's tender mercy which is available to all who turn to Him with trust. The floodgates of God's mercy are opened.

A plenary indulgence is granted on the Feast of Divine Mercy to all the faithful who go to Confession*, receive Holy Communion*, pray for the intentions of the Holy Father* "in any church or chapel, (in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin) take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, and recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. 'Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!')." "

A partial indulgence (the remission of some temporal punishment from sin) is granted to the faithful "who, at least with a contrite heart, pray to the merciful Lord Jesus a legitimately approved invocation."

**It is appropriate, but not necessary, that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulgenced work is performed; but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act.*
